The overall objective of the Pre-Kindergarten Program is to provide developmentally-appropriate, early-intervention services for the students. To increase that probability that the students will have a successful and positive experience upon entering school.

Program Objective Outline

1. The identification and remediation of educational disadvantage that could interfere with school adjustment and success.
2. To help each child to develop a positive self-concept through greater awareness of his/her role as a creation of God within the social surroundings.
3. Promoting language communication among children and between children and adults.

Instruction Approach

To address the cognitive, physical, social and language development needs of students. Students, through a child-centered environment will learn:

1. The use of self-discipline
2. To talk and listen effectively
3. To solve problems and make decisions
4. To accept some responsibility for their behavior
5. To share and work together with other classmates
6. To recognize that they are IMPORTANT as individuals and understand God's great love for everyone

The Pre-kindergarten curriculum will provide instructional direction. The daily schedule will be comprised of a blend of individual, small and large group activities. The students will be provided with opportunities to develop social skill, cooperation, helping, sharing, negotiation, which will aid the students in developing interpersonal problem solving skill. Students will also be provided opportunities to see how reading and writing are useful through study and identifying letter names and sounds.
